The Application shall be sent to the attention of: IFSS Accreditation Committee (accreditation@sleddogsport.net) and cc'd to the IFSS Executive Director at (executivedirector@sleddogsport.net).

Approval by the IFSS member federation shall be attached to the application.

Each country within a continent is limited to 5 x Dryland, 4 x Sled Sprint, 4 Ski-Dogs and 4 Distance Events per season, with the exception of Canada and USA where they are limited to 10 Dryland, 10 x Sled Sprint, 10 Ski-Dogs and 10 Distance Events per season

In order for the results to be included in the World Cup point calculation data base, the Event Liaison Officer shall send the events results by email in the specified Excel format (format to be included with approval letter sent by IFSS), within seven days of the conclusion of the event, to the IFSS Accreditation Committee (accreditation@sleddogsport.net) who will be responsible for calculating and publishing results on the Internet. Results not received in time will lead to the reject of the World Cup application the following year.

Cancellation

If an event is cancelled, relocated or rescheduled for any reason, the Accreditation Committee shall be informed and a new accreditation requested as soon as possible but not later than five days prior to the initial date of the event.

Advertising your Race ***IMPORTANT***

If the race is advertised as an IFSS accredited event, IFSS requests that the following wording be used in any specific advertising designation or claim:

"IFSS Accredited Event" or "IFSS World Cup Race" or "IFSS World Cup Event"

The wording must be used in full and cannot be used in any other form or way unless approved by IFSS. You may request the IFSS logo from IFSS (<u>executivedirector@sleddogsport.net</u>) or (<u>sport@sleddogsport.net</u>) if you wish to

use it in the advertising and promotion of your race. If your race has a website, IFSS requests that you have a link on it to the IFSS website (www.sleddogsport.net).
